Civic leader training plan launched

Leadership Evansville, an organization created to develop civic leaders through programs of intensive education and research, was born Friday after months of planning.

The brainchild of the Junior League of Evansville, Leadership Evansville was officially organized at a meeting of its steering committee on the campus of the University of Evansville.

The 26 members of the steering committee became the first board of directors, with a 21st member — who also will serve as general chairman — to be named within a month.

Leadership Evansville's role, according to a spokesperson, will be "to provide a continuing community resource of men and women capable of directing the community toward its future."

Objectives of the organization include:

- "Developing and encouraging leadership opportunities in the community."
- "Identifying and developing potential leaders of the community."
- "Developing a realistic understanding of leadership roles in our complex community."
- "Providing an alumni association."

The program is not intended as a problem-solving organization, said Nicholas. "We're not in it to solve problems. We're in it to help people to solve their own problems."

"Rather, it will seek to develop a self-actuating base of community leaders through an in-depth study of community needs in the Evansville area."

The in-depth study for each class participants, according to the Leadership Evansville plan, will include monthly progress reports on critical issues and objectives.

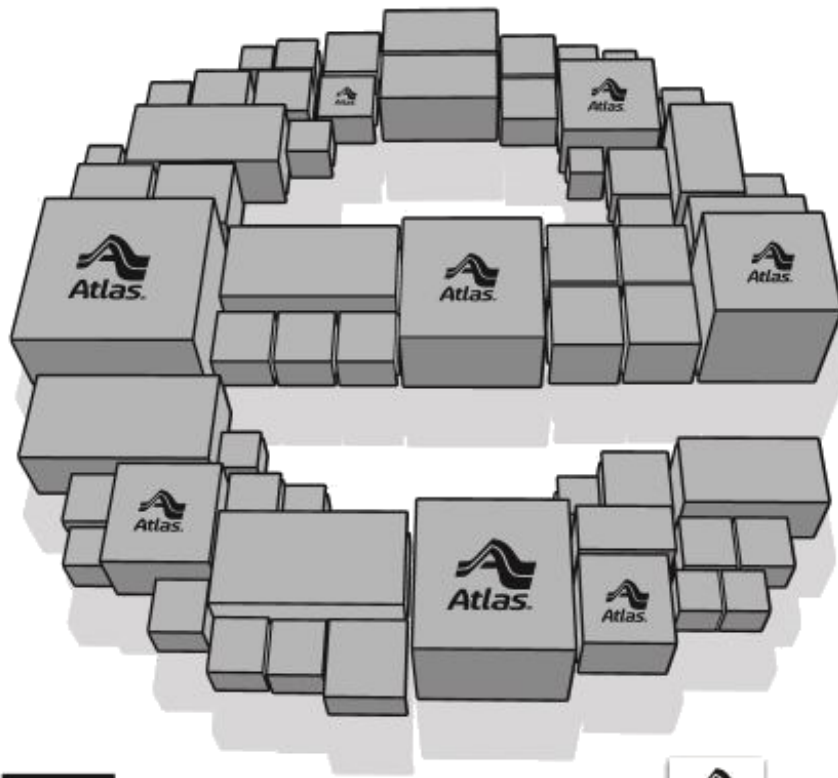

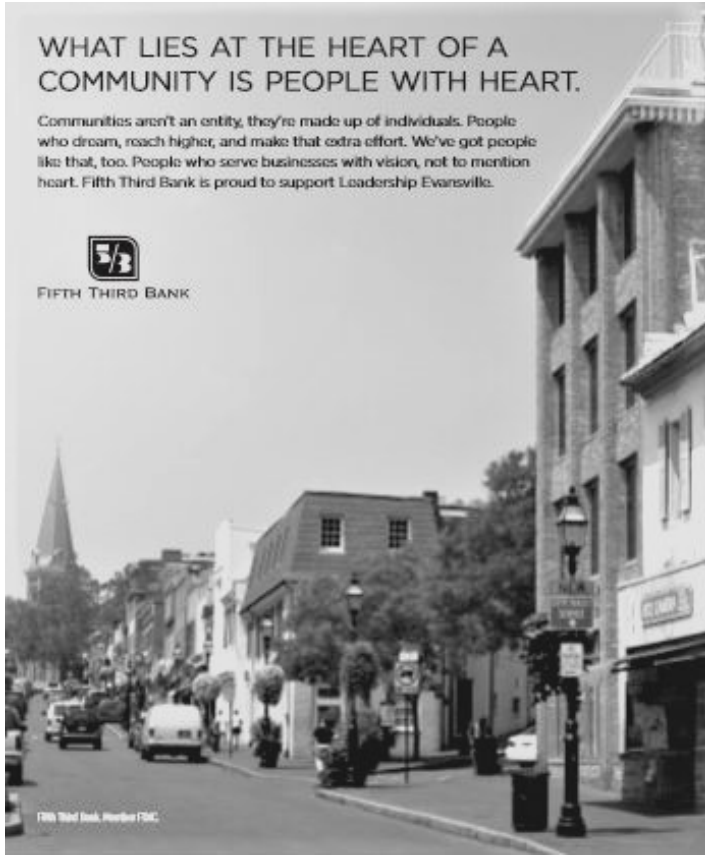

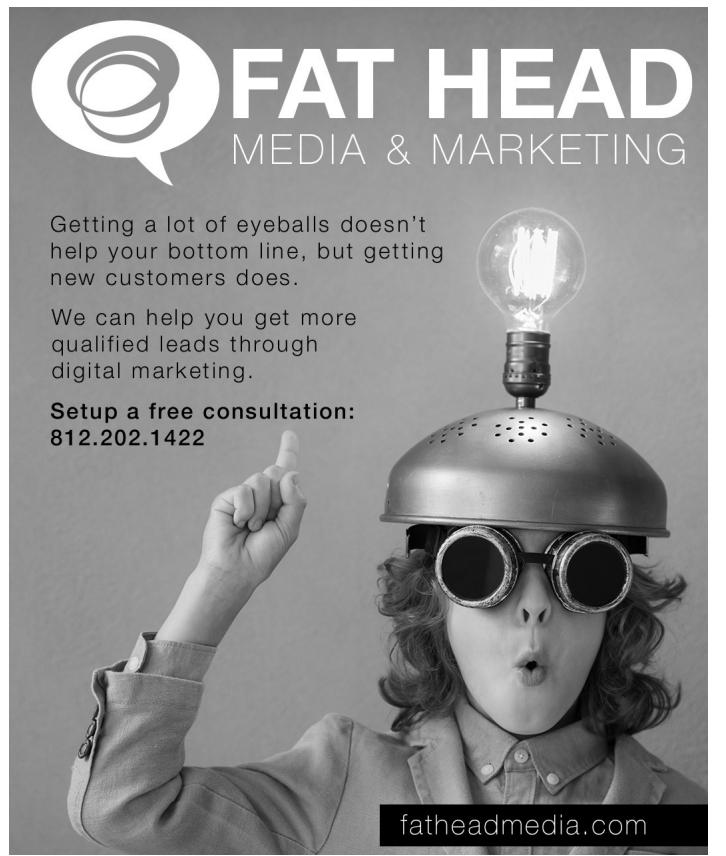

Ohio River boosts local economy

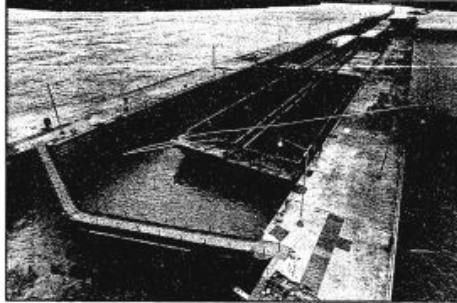
Leadership Evansville told about benefits of shipping industry

The Ohio River shipping industry quietly moves more than \$1 billion worth of commodities through the Evansville region every year, according to the owner of an Evansville marine service company.

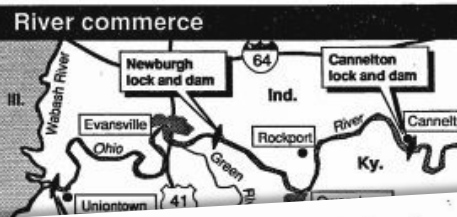
The Evansville region is probably the richest along the Ohio in shipping commodities, moving about 16 percent of the traffic tonnage in the Ohio River basin, according to Paul Legeay, president and owner of Evansville Barge & Marine Service Inc. Yet Legeay says few area residents are aware of the economic benefits.

"Everybody comes to the riverfront during Thunder," Legeay said, referring to the annual "Thunder on the Ohio" boat race.

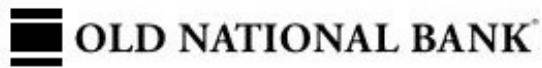



Two weeks after challenging people to dream what Haynie's Corner could become, Lynn Miller asked for something more Tuesday. "What we're looking for now is strategic action," said Miller. "Look at what we can do in a week and in a month."

The Leadership Evansville director issued the call to action as she opened a meeting of five dozen artists, homeowners, business owners, government officials, community organizers, activists and others who gathered Tuesday at Patchwork Central.

They broke up into groups, working on 11 ideas culled from an initial brainstorming session two weeks ago for the Alhambra Theatre, Haynie's Corner and the idea of an arts colony or district centered on the near-Downtown plaza and neighborhood at the intersection of Southeast Second Street and Washington Avenue.

Like the first meeting, the follow-up session brought together a cross-section of people from the neighborhood and beyond. It was Bob Haynie, whose great-grandfather, George W. Haynie, in 1888 built a drugstore that became a landmark.

The store burned down in 1944, to be replaced by a market. Later, as the neighborhood revitalized, a less appealing ring, noted Haynie, often associated with crime.

"It was troubling to me," he said. He said the neighborhood was named for geese.

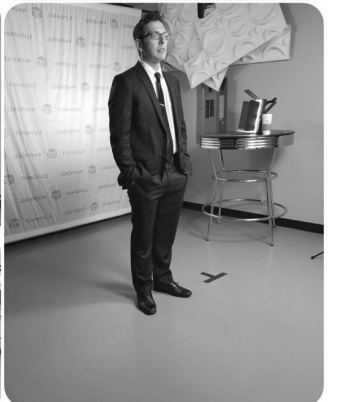
